We are proud to announce the debut of two acts we couldn't be more excited to finally bring to the festival.

Storming out of the UK are Easy Star Records warriors **THE SKINTS**, bringing the true ska and reggae vibes, laced with hard-hitting punk energy. Also set to make his Fest debut is Hawaiian sensation **MIKE LOVE**. With his unflinchingly positive message and a wholly unique voice, the vocal wizard and his guitar have left a trail of delighted audiences wherever they go. We are so excited to be able to bring both of these important acts to the Ska & Reggae Fest family.

Making their return this year are Colombian reggae mischief makers **SKAMPIDA**.

It's been a minute since the genre-melding group has graced our stages and we can't wait to get down and rowdy with them this summer. Also returning are west coast legends **ROOTS ROUNDUP**, a band that not only had a formative effect on our Festival leader, but on the Canadian reggae scene as a whole.

After a hiatus, Roots Roundup is back together and ready to get the people moving.

Victoria's BATUQUE AXÉ (featuring Axé Capoeira Victoria) are ready to bring something new and enthralling to the Ship Point stage this year. The powerful 12-piece mixes reggae and funk with traditional Brazilian music as the soundtrack for displays of the stunning Brazilian dance known as Capoeira.

Making their Canadian debut, are Colombian roots-reggae warriors MISTICA. Founded by the bass player from Ska & Reggae Fest veterans Providencia, Mistica has quickly become one of South America's hottest reggae exports.

Part of what makes this special festival is the relationship it has with the city that we call home.

Once again Victoria Ska & Reggae Festival will make its home in the Downtown core with shows at our marquee venue at Ship Point in the Inner Harbour as well as shows taking place at a variety of venues throughout the downtown core.
